

O' Grady Park Address: 37000 190th Ave SE Auburn WA 98092

Located along the Green River. Gravel road descends down to meadow along river.

Driving directions: from Auburn Hwy 164 turn left on SE 400th. Left again on 180th, right on 384th St and left again on 188th Ave SE, dead end road. Turn around then park alongside road.

The 922-acre Green River Natural Area extends slightly north from the edge of the Enumclaw Plateau. Steep valley walls and a broad valley floor combine to create rich mosaics of plant communities that characterize the natural area. Mixed forest and deciduous upland forests cover much of the valley wall, with several forested and scrub-shrub wetlands nestled in the benches. Gallery cottonwood forests, deciduous forests, meadows (old pasture/agricultural fields), and forested, scrub-shrub, and emergent wetlands are common on the valley bottom.
