
"Learning Opportunity February 25th, 2017"



Learn how to fit a pack saddle's tree to a horse, pony, mule, or donkey's back.

Pack saddle trees bars, are prior to shaping never meant

to fit well onto the back of any pack animal, basically they are a blank form ready to be shaped. To do this we will need to clamp the tree in a vice to stop any movement and contour the bars with a rasp or grinder to fit the shape of a pack animal's back. There will be two horses at this gathering of different shaped backs and two brand new Decker saddles that will be rasped to fit them. (Note: in the photo is a short backed Haflinger Horse. The saddle she is caring has shortened bars and is shaped to fit a very difficult back.) Come on by and learn how to make packing safer and more comfortable for your pack stock.
