

## Teanaway Community Forest

State lands managed jointly by WDFW and DNR. See boundary map for lands covered.

Two campgrounds for stock, Bruce Tropple in the Middle Fork, or Teanaway Campground on the West Fork.

### Bruce Tropple:

From the west - Interstate 90 to exit 85 (Jct 903, 970 Cle Elum Wenatchee). At the T intersection coming off the ramp turn right to Wenatchee & Leavenworth. Follow State Route 970 to milepost 6.90 - Teanaway Road (on the left) :

From the east - Interstate 90 to exit 106 (97 North Wenatchee). At the end of the ramp turn right on to W University Way. Drive 0.1 mile and turn left on to US Route 97 N. Continue on US 97 for 15.7 miles to the junction with State Route 970. Turn left on to SR 970 and continue 3.4 miles to Teanaway Road on the right (milepost 6.90). An alternate route would be to follow State Route 10 to State Route 970 but this is actually a bit longer than taking US 97.

Turn onto Teanaway Road and follow it for 7.3 miles just past the Teanaway River bridge (on a sharp curve to the right). Turn left onto the W Fork Teanaway Road and continue for 0.7 miles to a "Y". Keep right on the Middle Fork Teanaway Road and drive another 3.9 miles to camp. The road is paved up to the last 1.2 miles to camp.

### Teanaway Campground:

Follow the directions off Interstate 90 per above. Turn onto Teanaway Road and follow it for 7.3 miles just past the Teanaway River bridge (on a sharp curve to the right). Turn left onto the W Fork Teanaway Road and continue for 0.7 miles to a "Y". Stay straight and just beyond the "Y" on your left is the campground entrance.
