Location	Kennedy Creek Watershed Riding Area, GPS coordinates 47.089796, -123.092182	
Directions from I-5	Near Olympia, WA, approximately 12 miles from Interstate 5. From the I-5 (Northbound or Southbound): Take exit 104, go about 5.5 miles, take exit for Hwy 101 to Shelton/Port Angeles, go about 4 miles, turn left on Old Olympic Highway, go about half a mile, turn left into the Kennedy Creek area (entrance will be flagged), go about a half mile and turn right into ride camp. Good roads. Cell service available.	
Camping	Large field with easy access for big rigs, horse water only. Porta-potties provided. Spread manure. This field is owned and used by the Taylor Shellfish company, so there may be work items (neatly piled) in camp, please leave them be so we can be invited back! Dogs must be on a leash at all times! Ride camp is next to a salmon creek. Dogs in the Pacific Northwest can acquire Salmon Poisoning Disease after ingesting raw fish.	
Trails	Kennedy Creek was chosen with night riding in mind. Trails are non-technical to increase safety. The trails are well maintained logging roads with some single track.	
Schedule (subject to change)	Friday, July 7	Ride Camp opens 8 a.m. Friday morning or by approval of Ride Mgmt
Day Ride (non-sanctioned trail ride)	Saturday, July 8	Checkin and signup between 8 a.m.-12 p.m. Trail open to "day riders" between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. "Day riders" must be off the course by 4 p.m. Helmets required when mounted.
Midnight Rider vet-in	Saturday, July 8	Vet-In between 3-7 p.m.
Clinic	Saturday, July 8	4:30-5:30 p.m. Everyone is welcome. Night Riding Clinic by Sue Summers
Dinner	Saturday, July 8	5:30-7:30 p.m., staggered, eat when you're ready!
Ride Meeting	Saturday, July 8	7:00 p.m.
Midnight Rider start	Saturday, July 8	8:30 p.m.–This should give riders almost 1.5 hours of daylight/twilight riding. Helmets required when mounted. Logbooks required by EDRA club members.
Cost	Midnight Rider	\$80 ride entry (includes dinner)
	Day Rider	\$25 ride entry (see below for dinner cost, no charge for clinic)
	Dinner	Included in Midnight Rider entry fee; \$10 for all others
	Clinic	No charge, everyone welcome
Awards and other:	Headlamps will be given to the Midnight Riders. T-shirts will also be available.
